

Succession means continuous planting so that they aren't all ripe at one time.

Cool Season Vegetables

Vegetable	Succession or 1 time & plant by seed or transplant	Planting date	# plants per sq. foot
Carrots	Succession by seed	April-August	16
Beets	Succession by seed	April-July	9
Turnips	Succession by seed	April-August	9
Spinach	Succession by seed	March-April, August	12
Peas	Succession by seed	February-April	1-2 inches apart & grow up trellis
Lettuce	Succession by seed or transplant	April-September	4
Broccoli	1 time by seed or transplant	March or July	1
Cabbage	1 time by seed or transplant	April or July	1
Cauliflower	1 time by seed or transplant	April or July	1
Brussel Sprouts	Succession by seed or transplant	May-July	1
Garlic	1 time by garlic cloves	September & October	9
Kale	Succession by seed or transplant	Feb-March & June-July	4

These save a lot of space! Trellis set on north side of plot.

Warm Season Vegetables

Vegetable	Succession or 1 time & plant by seed or transplant	Planting date	# plants per sq. foot
Tomato	1 time by transplant	May 15-June 1	1 per 4 sq. ft.
Pepper	1 time by transplant	May 15-June 1	1
Eggplant	1 time by transplant	May 15-June 1	1
Cucumber	1 time by seed	May 15-June 1	1 - if trellising 1 per 4 sq. ft. if not trellising
Squash (summer & winter)	1 time by seed or transplant	May 15-June 1	1 - if trellising 1 per 4 sq. ft. if not trellising
Basil	1 time by seed	May 15-June 1	4
Beans (bush)	Succession by seed	May 15-June 15	9
Beans (pole)	1 time by seed	May 15-June 1	4 inches apart & grow up a trellis
Tomatillo	1 time by transplant	May 15-June 1	1
